# Parsonage News

Our church parsonage, which has provided very nice housing for our pastors and their families, will turn 60 years old this year. The parsonage committee and directors are evaluating many needed repairs and updates, and some preparations for the repairs and upgrades have begun.

## Outside

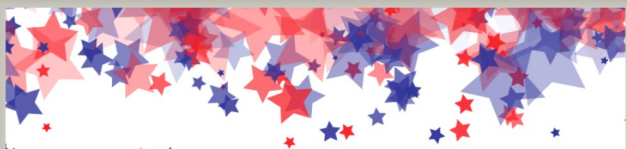
We removed the old white fence, cleaned up the area where the fence used to stand, and installed a temporary fence on the correct property line between the church property and the property behind the parsonage. In the near future a more permeant fence will be needed to indicate the property line boundary between the properties. As has been discussed for a year or more, the roof on the parsonage is in desperate need of replacement. Some painting and other minor repairs are needed on the exterior of the parsonage.

## Inside

A main sewer line issue was addressed to remove some cast iron pipe scale that was blocking water flow from a few plumbing fixtures. Eventually more invasive measures will be needed to address older pipes that are poured into concrete. The current repair should be sufficient for a few years. While removing the old worn, stained carpets from the upstairs and middle level of the parsonage, we discovered beautiful hardwood floors! These floors will be finished providing an updated appearance and solid flooring for many years to come. Laminate flooring will be installed in the den and bedroom/office area on the main floor of the parsonage. All rooms will be painted and freshened up. The electrical switches and outlets, most of which are original to the house, along with some lighting fixtures will be upgraded. Three of the original exterior doors will be replaced with energy efficient doors. The doors have cracks in the panels that allow light to show through, many coats of old paint, and dated hardware – all of which make the doors look very bad. All of the interior doors are original to the house, are economy grade, have many old coats of paint, and many have repaired holes in them. The hardware on the doors is also very old. As a result, the overall appearance of the doors is very poor. Estimates are being gathered for these repairs and more updates will be reported in the near future.

Doug and Monica Levy will be living in the parsonage during our time of transition. Housing availability in our area has been a bit of a challenge for them. One of their goals when moving back to the area from California was to find affordable home ownership, and they are working toward making that goal a reality. They feel loved and blessed by all that are helping them get settled back into the community.

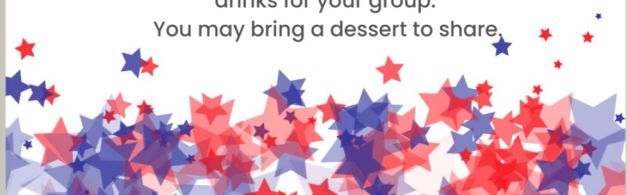

### WEO LUNCHEON

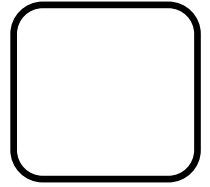
